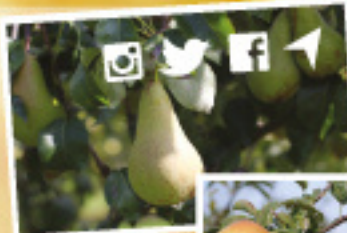

Set in 150 acres, Brogdale is home to the National Fruit Collection, the largest collection of fruit trees in the world. Discover over 2,100 different varieties of apples alone, as well as pears, cherries, plums, quince, medlars and other bush fruits. The varieties are rich in historic stories and have wonderful associations with names and places across the globe. 2021 sees 13 years of Brogdale Collections working to provide public access & education.

Daily Guided Orchard Tours

Explore history, heritage & treasures in the orchards. Our knowledgeable guides will take you on a journey from spring blossom to fruit filled trees. Your guide will answer questions and awaken your taste buds with samples of fruit. With over 4,000 different varieties you will never be short of something to see! Tours run daily leaving at 11am, 1pm & 2.30pm throughout the season (April - October). 1 hour (approx.)
